Economy	The amount of money that a country can generate. .
Rainforest	A biome that has a wets season and a dry season. The high temperatures make it a great place for lots of wildlife.
Favela	These are slums. Slums are an area of poor-quality housing, built out of the materials you can find.
Deforestation	The cutting down of trees to sell wood and create farmland.
Climate change	The unnatural heating up of the planet by humans. It is also called 'global warming'.
Endangered	When an animal or a plant is at risk of becoming extinct (dying out forever).
