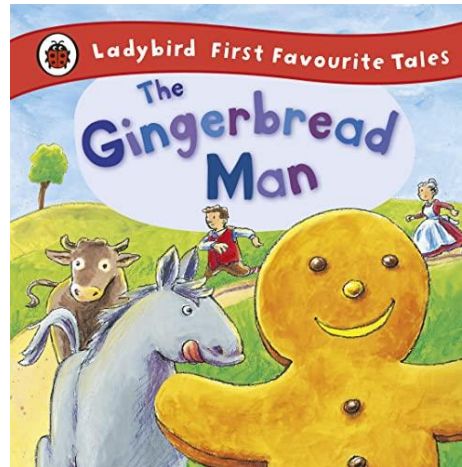
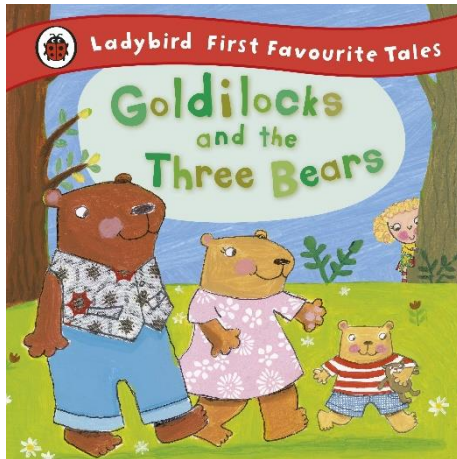




Once Upon A Time! Traditional Tales



Key Vocabulary

Traditional Tale	A story that has been retold over many years. Sometimes called a fairy tale.
Setting	Where a story takes place.
Character	A person, animal or creature in a story.
Hero	The main character in a story. A hero is usually a character who is good and well-liked.
Villain	The villain could be mean, nasty or evil! Villain. The character who is the opposite of the hero.
Plot	It describes the events that make up a story.
Title	The name of our story or what it is called
Author	The person who wrote our story
Illustrator	The person who drew the pictures
Moral	The lesson or message the story is teaching. A story with a moral is called a Fable.
Structure	A story is made up of a beginning, middle and end.
