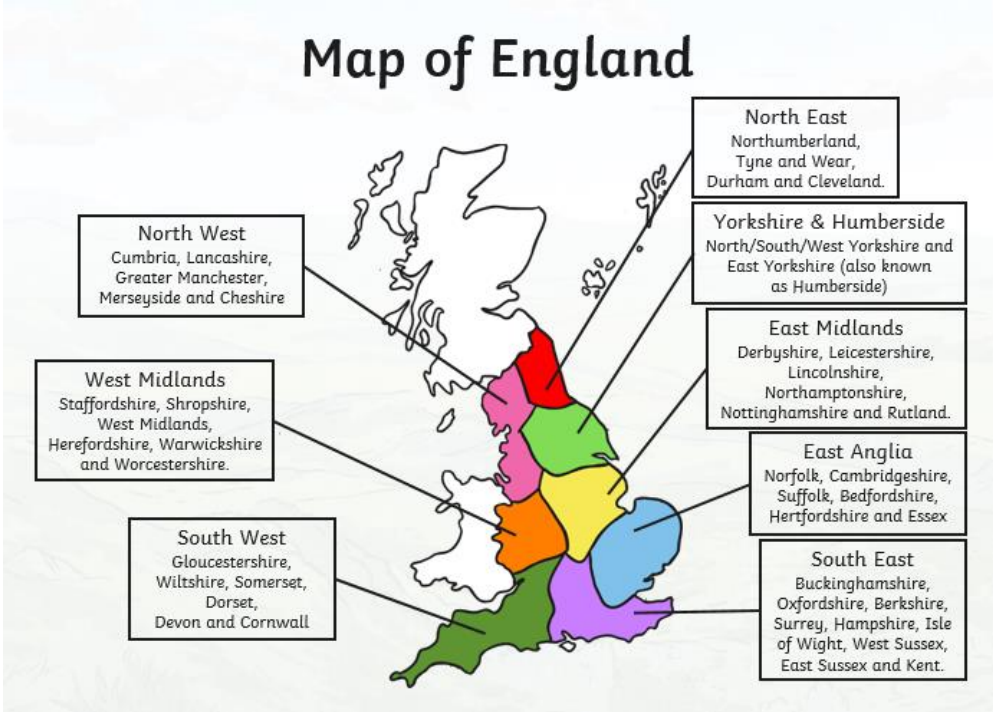

United Kingdom		Map of England  North West Cumbria, Lancashire, Greater Manchester, Merseyside and Cheshire West Midlands Staffordshire, Shropshire, West Midlands, Herefordshire, Warwickshire and Worcestershire. South West Gloucestershire, Wiltshire, Somerset, Dorset, Devon and Cornwall North East Northumberland, Tyne and Wear, Durham and Cleveland. Yorkshire & Humberside North/South/West Yorkshire and East Yorkshire (also known as Humberside) East Midlands Derbyshire, Leicestershire, Lincolnshire, Northamptonshire, Nottinghamshire and Rutland. Country	A country is an area the world is divided into, covering a particular area of land.		
City	Is a large town, usually containing a cathedral. A city is a place where many people live closely together.		
County	A county is an area of the UK which has its own local government. Lancashire is the county we live in.		
region	An area of the UK (boundaries).		
metropolitan	Is a large urban area. A metropolitan area may be much larger than its inner city, and its suburbs may be smaller towns and villages which are now connected to the larger city as it has grown		
urban	An area where many people live and work close together		
mountain	A mountain is a very high area of land with steep sides.		
Greater Manchester	The county that Bolton is in.		
suburb	Is an area of a <u>town</u> or <u>city</u> , a little away from the main part, where there are fewer big <u>buildings</u> and mainly <u>houses</u> , <u>schools</u> and <u>shops</u> .
