Dear Parent / Carer,

Our school has commissioned Global Policing, to work with the school to support our attendance processes. We already work with Global Policing in a number of areas within the school.

Global Policing are a team of ex-police officers who look to support children, families and the school to help young people get the best start in life and make the right choices as they grow up.

We are excited that the school and Global Policing can work together to support you and look at ways to help your children attend school more often. They are not an enforcement organisation and are no longer police officers. However, with the skills and experience they have, I believe they are best placed to help us with attendance matters going forwards.

They will be supporting families if a child's attendance falls below our expected attendance levels, if the child is persistently late or does not turn up to school without any notification.

Global Policing will, on occasion, contact you if your child falls into one of the categories above. I do want to stress, that they will be positive and supportive at all times, they will not make any judgements about you. Being independent from the school they might be able to support you in ways the school can't.

The Global Policing Attendance Officer who makes contact will be treated as part of the school team and as such will have access to necessary school data regarding your family.
